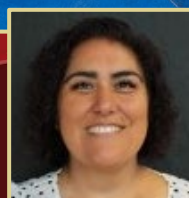

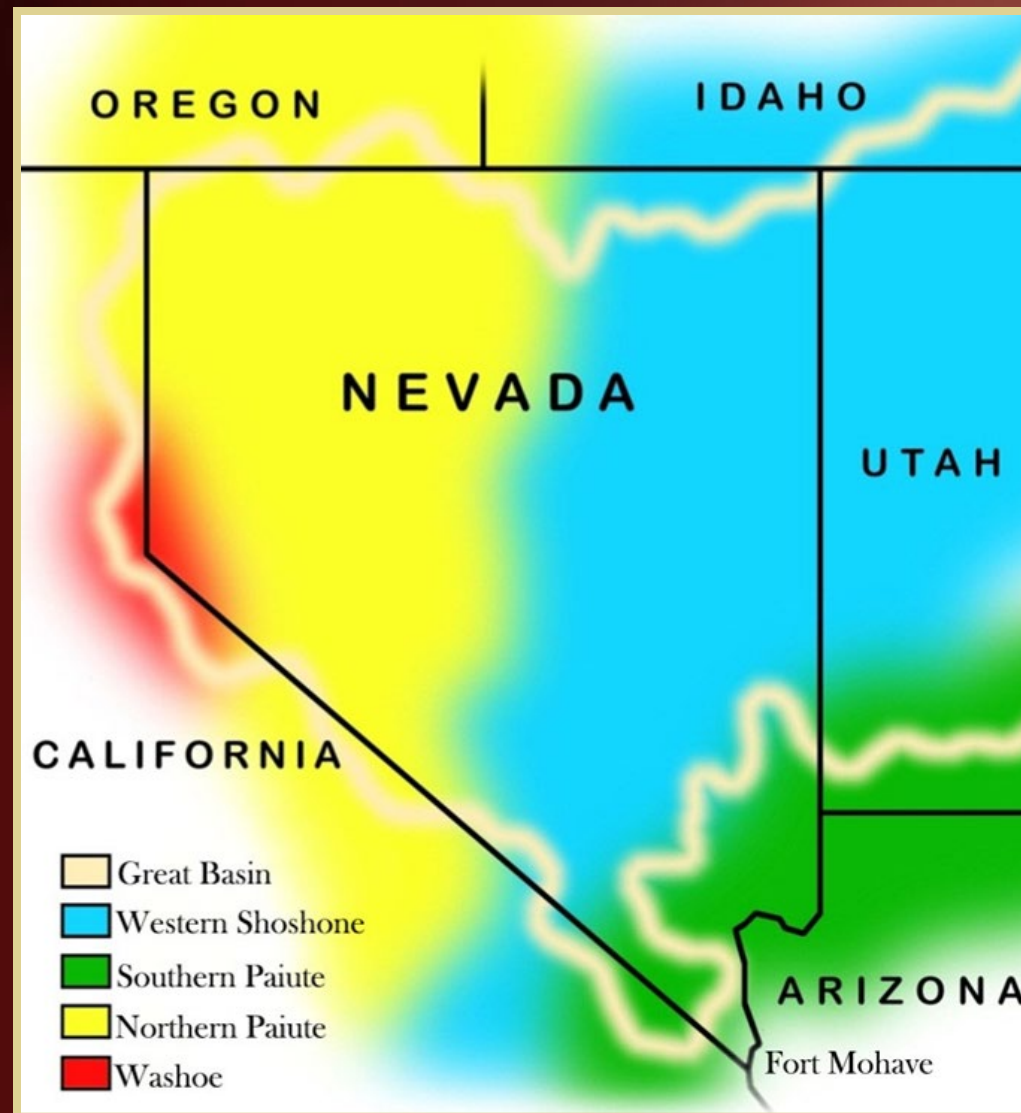

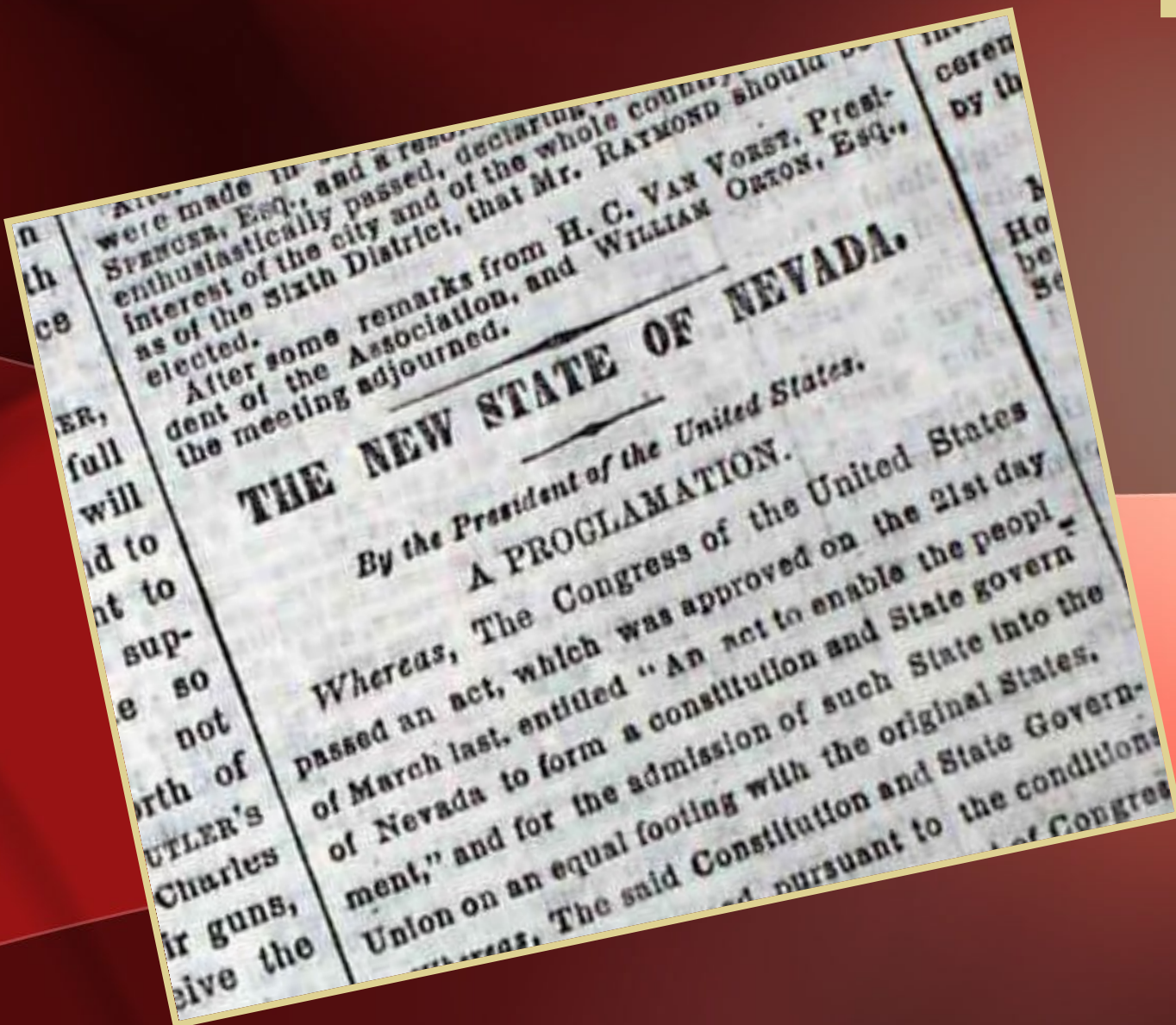
LAND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

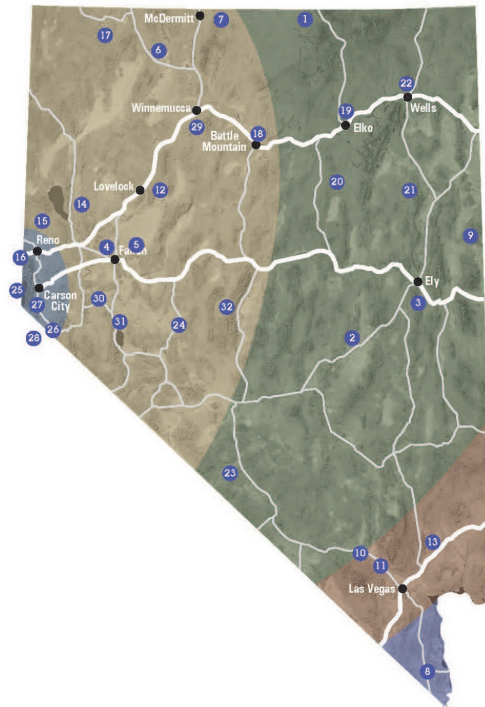

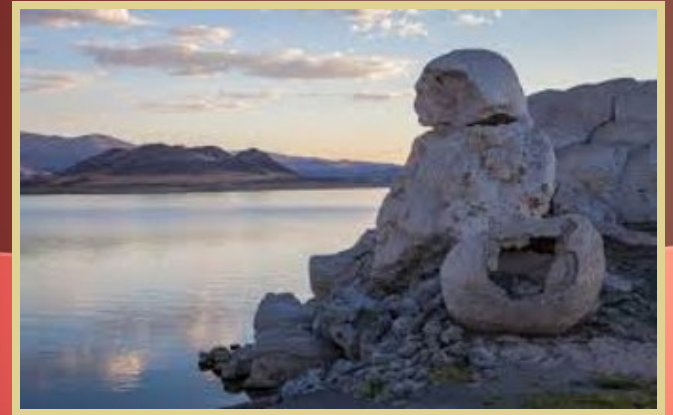
