- 3. Revisions made by Tribe, resubmit to NIC ARPA Team for review,
- 4. After reviewed, recommendation made by NIC ARPA Team for approval of application to State ARPA Team for review and approval.
- 5. State ARPA will either approve or recommend changes to the application.
- 6. If approved, NIC notifies Tribe of approval of application.
- 7. Arrangements made for Agreement signing by the Tribal Leader.
