2024 Election Quick Reference Guide



2024 will have three elections held by the State of Nevada

Presidential Preference Primary: Feb. 6, 2024	Early Voting: Jan. 27 - Feb. 2, 2024
Primary Election: June 11, 2024	Early Voting: May 25 - June 7, 2024
General Election: Nov. 5, 2024	Early Voting: Oct. 19 - Nov. 1, 2024

What do I need to know about the Presidential Preference Primary on February 6th?

- Only voters registered as Democrats or Republicans may vote in the Presidential Preference Primary:
 - In order to participate, you must update your party registration if you are not registered in one of the two Major Parties.
 - You may update your party registration with appropriate documentation, including on Election Day.
- Only candidates who filed for the Presidential Preference Primary will appear on the ballot, and you may only vote in your party's primary.
- The Presidential Preference Primary is non-binding. Major parties are responsible for how they select their nominee for president.

Other 2024 Elections information:

- Update your voter registration (including address and contact information) as soon as possible to receive the most up-to-date elections information through 2024.
- **Register to vote or update your registration online at: RegisterToVote.NV.gov**
- Mail ballots will be sent to active registered voters. Ballots can be returned by mail or to an official dropbox in your County.
- NVEASE.gov is also available for active duty military and their dependents, Nevadans who are out of the country, Nevada voters with a disability and tribal voters who live on a colony or reservation.
